A MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD CHAIR

The Unified Board of Peace United would like to thank everyone for generously giving their time and financial support to Peace UC in the first half of 2024.



Mission and Service Donations are up \$170 from 2023 and over \$5,900 has been forwarded to date.

General Funds are down \$2,500 from last year, but as fundraising efforts are tallied up, it is close to a breakeven year so far.

Anne Rounding first mentioned Fundscrip to our congregation last fall. Her promotion of the gift card program, the support of the Fundraising Committee and your card purchases have earned Peace over \$2,000 since then. Thanks!

The carpet has been ordered from Yantzi Home Building Centre in Tavistock and will be replaced in August when worship services are not being held. We are grateful that Bev Poll included Peace UC in her will. Her bequest is covering the majority of the cost of the new carpet.

Here's the second half of the poppy banners for the Bright Gates! Our plans include 2 for the Chesterfield Cenotaph and 2 for the Plattsville Gates.


Keep knitting and crocheting poppies. If we don't use them this year, we will next year.


